

# Fueling needs of the community

The Perry County Department of Job and Family Services is offering a fuel assistance program to employed income-eligible individuals through Aug. 31, or until funds are exhausted.

Eligible individuals must be a resident of Perry County, have a minor child who has not attained 18 years of age or have a child who is 19 and a full-time student, be employed at least 25 hours per week and living at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

## **Family Size Monthly Gross Income Guidelines**

- 2 \$2,452**
- 3 \$3,089**
- 4 \$3,725**
- 5 \$4,362**

Applicants are required to provide proof of identity, pay stubs for the past 30 days of employment and a social security number.

Monthly fuel vouchers are issued from the agency in the amounts of \$50 or \$100, depending on miles traveled to employment. Once determined eligible, applicants could receive up to \$400 over the span of the program.

Applications are accepted in person Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
