
## **Child Support**

## Support is Key!

To review request due to unemployment or laid off due to mass layoff:

- Contact our agency to obtain a Request for an Administrative Review
- A review will not lower the arrears already owed on a child support case
- Note that results of an Administrative Review is an attempt to lower the amount of the current support owed, but is not guaranteed.
- Once a request is approved, information packets will be sent out to both parties and they will have 30 days to return all needed information to the agency for the Administrative Review.
- Recommendations will be sent to both parties, with an objection time frame of 10 days. If no objections, the order will be sent to the courts. If there is an objection, both parties will be contacted for an Administrative Hearing.


