Perry County OhioMeansJobs Center and Social Services Relocates

We've moved! Why? Because our community needs training and career services now more than ever, our families can't get back to work without childcare, and the pandemic is leaving our older adults so isolated and vulnerable. This move gives us the space to better meet these growing needs of our community.

Starting immediately, the new location where our OhioMeansJobs, Adult Protective Services and Childcare teams will be working to serve you is at the County Home Farm site, in the Perry Campus building of Hocking College, located at 5454 OH37, New Lexington. We're right across from the Perry County fairgrounds.

Our move also includes Perry County Mobility Management, and this will help connect people from across the county to the activities and resources in our new location.

This move is first step in building a new center of community opportunity and support for all in Perry County. There will more resources and services brought to the County Home Farm location for which we'll have news to share, but we're excited that much of the work we do has found a new home there.
